


**Directions:** Print and laminate the number cards and workmats and cut them apart. (Print on cardstock for more durability!)


Have students work independently or with a partner to place the missing numbers in the correct space on the workmat.

After filling in the missing numbers, students may complete one of the worksheets to record their answers.


